I had 5 guest cabins and could comfortably host 12 guests. I was responsible for stowing the boat prior to the Trans-Atlantic Crossing to Antigua. During the crossing, I took charge of inventorying the entire interior department and turning the boat ready for the Antigua Yacht Charter Show, together with the other stewardess onboard. During the yacht show, I welcomed guests onboard, provided wine service during a themed brokers lunch onboard.
