

Following the refit, the owners, along with their family and friends, enjoyed six months of cruising throughout Florida, the Florida Keys and the Bahamas before successfully launching the yacht into a busy charter season. In April 2023 I transitioned from my role to take on a new opportunity aboard a more modern vessel. |
