In the Italian Navy I played piano in the orchestra, trained for special operations, was a combat helicopter pilot and in 1978 I volunteered for an extraction mission rescuing 126 American POW's from Vietnam. I finished my career with the privilege to be assigned as AID Officer to the 2nd Italian Navy Division Admiral in Chief Girolamo Fantoni.

After my service in the Italian Navy, I followed my father's footsteps and became a professional race car driver, engine developer, and designer of LeMans style prototype cars. I am a certified engine rebuilder for Ferrari and Lamborghini and have been part of the development of racing offshore marine engines assisting Lamborghini Marine and teams such as Victory Italia and GEICO with Walbro TDD and Magneti Marelli Motorsport.

Advancements in technology, specifically electronics, led me into developing alternative fuel systems for combustion engines. These systems have been used by government and private industry where alternative fuels such as Methane, Propane, Ethane, Hydrogen, and Dimethyl Ether are used.
