This Vessel was a 2015 68 Predator Sunseeker. Aboard this vessel I was the First mate as well as the relief captain. Owner wanted docked at marina every night so this was a 5 day trip. We transported this vessel from Fort Lauderdale, Florida to New Rochelle, New York.

On this vessel I was the Mate/Deckhand During daily charters. Aboard this vessel we did daily sightseeing charters, sunset cruises, dinner party's, and corporate party's. I helped with lines and docking, navigation, and as well as cleaning maintence. Cleaning maintence includes daily washing, drying, buffing and waxing.

With this company I mainly took customers out on fishing charters. I did backwater fishing as well as going offshore anywhere from 5 to 25 miles offshore catching just about everything the gulf has to offer. I also drove the beach shuttle from the Hyatt to the Hyatt's private island in Estero Bay.

This vessel was a 2008 112 Westport. While working on this vessel I served as the mate and in charge of the deck as I did daily cleaning and maintenance to the exterior of the boat. I would be in charge of fuel transfers. During trips I would take care of lines, take watch as we were underway and also at night. Also I would help the stew as needed.

2018 May/ June First Mate

This vessel was a 1977 143' Angus. During my time on this vessel I was in charge of over seeing contractors as it was in the process of being refit for Cuba charters. Also as the mate I was in charge of daily maintenance of the engine room, fuel transfers, strainer cleaning, exterior cleaning, and watches. During trip I would take care of the dock lines and fenders, tender, and engine room checks, as well as watch while underway.

This vessel was a 1999 82' Hargrave. During my time aboard this vessel I played many different roles as there was only two crew. Not only did I take care of daily cleaning of interior and exterior I also played as the stew and the chef. I cook most of the meals that was service on board. I was in charge of anchor watch and watch while underway. I did regular maintenance in the engine room, changing oil on generator, fuel transfers, cleaning of the strainers, and servicing the water maker as well as engine room checks during underway. I was also in charge of the tender and setting up tows.
